Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 2 - Educational Visit to Felixstowe Beach

We are excited to inform you about an upcoming educational trip for Year 2 pupils. Year 2 will be visiting Felixstowe Beach **on Wednesday 6th May** for a fun-filled day of learning and exploration.

Children should wear their usual school uniform, but will need to wear a comfortable pair of shoes for walking, such as trainers. The children will need to be prepared for all types of weather, so please send them to school appropriately dressed for the weather for that day.

Trip Details:

- **Departure from school:** The coach will leave school promptly, at **09:30 am**
- **Departure from Felixstowe:** The coach will leave Felixstowe at **14:15pm**
- **Activities:**
 - Strolling along the seafront
 - Creating land art inspired by the artist Jon Foreman
 - Building sand sculptures

What to bring:

- **Sunscreen:** Please apply sunscreen to your child before they come to school.
- **Hat:** To protect from the sun.

All children are entitled to a **free school packed lunch**, however if your child would prefer to bring a packed lunch from home they are more than welcome to do so - no fizzy drinks or sweets please. They will have to carry their own belongings such as spare clothes and their lunch, so please put everything inside a **named bag** such as a rucksack/backpack.



The total cost of the trip for the school is £400 and so, we are asking for a contribution of **£5.00** per child. If we do not receive enough contributions, then the trip may not be able to go ahead. Please provide your consent and money before **Wednesday 29th April 2026 via the MCAS app.**
