Trust Sports Day 2026

We are excited to inform you that our Year 6 pupils will be taking part in a Trust Sports Day against Murrayfield. This event is a fantastic opportunity for the children to showcase their sporting skills, teamwork, and school spirit.

The event is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 1st July at Piper's Vale. It will run entirely during normal school hours, so the children will have their lunch at school as usual.
