PE KIT EXPECTATIONS

Swimming Kit	PE Uniform
Pupils in Years 4, 5 & 6 will be going swimming throughout this year. You will be informed when your child will be taking part. Your child will need to bring: • Appropriate swimming attire (e.g. trunks/swim suit - no two piece) • A swimming hat • A towel Please ensure all earrings are removed before coming to school on Wednesdays. Please note that if earrings are not removed then a child cannot swim.	The expectation is that all pupils come into school in full PE uniform on their PE day/s. PE Uniform: • White t-shirt/polo shirt • Black/navy jogging bottoms • Black/navy shorts • Black/navy sweatshirt (no hoodies) • Trainers/plimsolls (No large logos on any P.E kit) Please ensure all jewellery is removed for PE(pupils should only ever be wearing a wristwatch and stud earrings to school anyway). If your child attends an After School Sports Clubs, then they need to bring a PE kit to get changed into at the end of that day.
